- circumstances which may encourage them to return to their home country and/or conditions that encourage them to remain in Australia
- circumstances which may encourage the request for a release letter to go to another city or downgrade in course

Please note that in some circumstances, Immigration may request evidence of English competence. This request differs from Curtin English language requirement.
